International Teachers Complete PermaSchool Training Course in Spain

Educators from Spain, Greece, and Cyprus recently gathered in Spain for an intensive week-long PermaSchool Training Course, marking a significant milestone in the Erasmus+ funded initiative to integrate permaculture into European classrooms.

The transnational teacher training equipped educators with practical permaculture knowledge, innovative pedagogical tools, and hands-on methodologies they can immediately implement in their schools. Participants engaged in collaborative learning sessions, exchanged best practices, and explored the project's comprehensive resources, including the School Educators Guidebook, the PermaSchool Curriculum and Activity Planning Tool.

What's Next

Building on this training success, the project will move forward with PermaStudent Lessons across all partner countries, where educators will deliver classes using the PermaSchool resources. Students will then develop their own permaculture projects, culminating in national PermaSchool Fairs in Spain, Greece, and Cyprus where student-led initiatives will be showcased to inspire other schools.
